WHAT TO CONSIDER.

Every company with group consolidated revenue of \$100 million or more should consider:

- its reporting obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2018 (Cth)
- how it will identify and address modern slavery risks in its business operations and supply chains.

THE ONLINE REGISTER.

A central repository for Australian companies' modern slavery statements is now [online](#).

DUE DATES EXTENDED.

Companies must submit a modern slavery statement within 6 months of the end of the company's financial year. Companies whose first reporting period ended on or before 30 June 2020 have a 3 month extension so that:

- companies previously required to report by 30 September 2020 now have until 31 December 2020
- companies previously required to report by 31 December 2020 now have until 31 March 2021.



Companies with a reporting period ending after 30 June 2020 have not been given an extension and must submit a modern slavery statement within 6 months of the end of the reporting period.
